£250,000 Harry's Quarter Million Bonus Series

A £25,000 Bonus will be paid to the first 10 Premier graduates who win a nominated Two-Year-Old Maiden race throughout the UK in the 2027 flat racing season.

The nominated races will incorporate a diverse selection of Two-Year-Old races from the start of the 2027 flat season until Harry's Half Million Day. The nominated races will carry the £25,000 Goffs Bonus which will be paid to the winning owner (90%) and trainer (10%). No horse may win more than one Bonus.

A full list of eligible races will be published when available and will be paid on a first win - first paid basis to a maximum of 10 Bonuses.

In the event that all 10 Bonuses have not been won by Harry's Half Million Day, the amount not won will be added to the Harry's Half Million by Goffs prize money.

Qualification Fee for Harry's 750 Series

A one-off qualification fee of £3,000 for the entire Harry's 750 Series (Harry's Half Million and Harry's Quarter Million Bonus Series) is payable at the point of purchase by ticking the box on the Acknowledgement of Purchase form. For the avoidance of doubt the qualification fee is non-refundable once declared and paid.

(The qualification fee will be added to the Goffs invoice. For horses not sold or bought back by the vendor Goffs must be informed within seven days of the

sale and the fee must be paid to Goffs to confirm eligibility).

NB The qualification fee is in addition to the race entry fees below.

The Harry's Half Million and Harry's Quarter Million Bonus Series is open to two-year-olds that were catalogued in the 2026 Premier Yearling Sale, have paid the qualification fee and have been declared by Goffs as eligible including:

- Horses sold under the hammer or privately at the sale through Goffs.
- Horses not sold or bought back by the vendor will qualify if the sale entry fee and full commission allowed in the Conditions of Sale is paid on the reserve price or Sale Price, whichever is the higher.
- Where a sale is cancelled under the Conditions of Sale horses will qualify if the sale entry fee and full commission allowed in the Conditions of Sale is paid on the Sale Price.
- Horses catalogued but withdrawn from the Premier Sale will qualify if they are subsequently catalogued and sold or bought back at the Goffs UK October Sale, Goffs Autumn Yearling Sale or GoffsGo Online Sales.

Should a buyer fail to tick the box at the point of purchase (or a vendor of an unsold lot fail to inform Goffs within seven days of the sale) a late qualification fee of £6,000 may be paid to qualify a lot for the entire Harry's Half Million by Goffs and £250,000 Premier Prize Series until the first entry stage listed below.

Payment must be made to Goffs within the terms laid out in the Conditions

of Sale and Goffs reserves the right to declare the lot ineligible for entry into the race.

Harry's Half Million by Goffs and the £250,000 Harry's Quarter Million Bonus Series are guaranteed by Goffs.

Race Entry Fees for Harry's Half Million

£2,000 to run (0.4% of the minimum prize fund):

- £2,000 via entry stages to Weatherbys:
 - £500 to enter by 12 noon on 12th January 2027
 - £500 unless forfeit by 12 noon on 4th May 2027
 - £500 unless forfeit by 12 noon on 6th July 2027
 - £500 unless forfeit by 12 noon on 13th August 2027
 - Declare by 10.00 am on 17th August 2027

Entries

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the full conditions of the race as published in the Racing Calendar and must be made to Weatherbys (or Horse

Racing Ireland for Irish entries, France Galop for French entries).

Naming

Naming applications must be received by Weatherbys no later than 6th July 2027. If an acceptable application has not been made by that date, the horse will be disqualified and removed from the race.

Maximum Runners

The 6-furlong limit at York Racecourse is 22. If more than that number are declared to run, the field will be reduced by the elimination of the horses that have the lowest official BHA Handicap rating on the day. The last two entry stakes payments totalling £1000 will be refunded to the owners of these horses.

These conditions are subject to alteration and Goffs reserves the right to change, amend or vary any detail, arrangement or condition in connection with any element of Harry's Half Million by Goffs and £250,000 Harry's Quarter Million Bonus Series at any time and without notice in their sole discretion. Furthermore, Goffs shall not incur any liability for any loss, damage or expense in any circumstances and regardless of the parties involved or the consequential loss incurred by any party.
